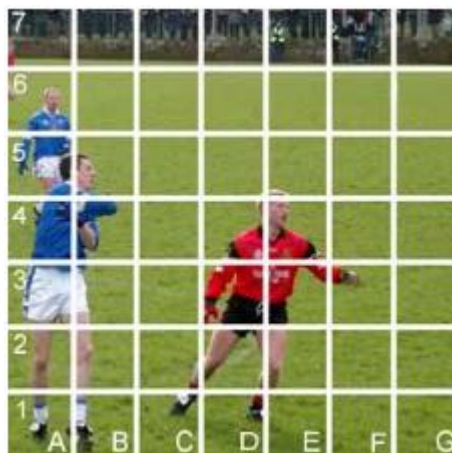

Fun Facts

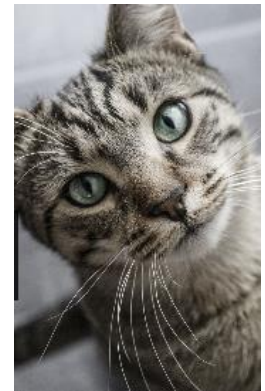


The 100 folds in a chef's hat represent 100 ways to cook an egg.
